Initial situation:

After Tempelhof Airport, the former McNair Barracks on Berlin's Goerzallee are the second largest monument in the capital: The site of the former Telefunken plant was expanded in 2007/2008 and a new residential district with a large number of duplexes/condominiums and exclusive residential buildings was built.
